Directions to Knowle Farm Hazelwood

From the South West,

You have two options here - which way do you go round Birmingham? Either:-

1.) Go all the way up the M5, join the M6 north, and carry on up to junction 11. Come off here and follow the signs for the A5. (Or use the M6 toll road. This will cost around £9 but will save you some time.) Stay on whichever road you chose for about 11 miles, and come off on the A38 north to Burton on Trent, and Derby. Pick up the directions below.

OR:-

2.) Head up the M5 to Junction 4a (M42) and follow the M42 for about 26 miles to junction 9.

(Around junction 9 you get the option of going onto the M6 toll road. This will cost you around £9 with minimal time saving in normal circumstances. Should you go this route, you should come off the toll road at the exit for the A5 and the A38 north.)

If you choose not to use the toll road, come off at junction 9 and follow the A446 signposted to (I think) Lichfield.

This is a complex junction, but follow the A446, and you should go past the Belfry hotel and golf club within a mile or so of getting off the motorway.

After about 5 miles on the A446 you get to a large roundabout (Bassett's Pole) where you turn basically right onto the A38, probably still signposted to Lichfield. This is dual carriageway.

A further three and a half miles and you pass under the A5, and a mile later turn right at another big roundabout staying on the A38 now signposted to Derby.

Then:-

After about 25 miles on the A38, you get to the Derby bypass (heralded by a 40 mph limit), stay on the A38, and you will get to a roundabout with an Esso garage and a McDonalds. This is the A52 - go straight over staying on the A38.

Within 400 yards, there is an exit to Kedleston Hall (among other places) which you ignore.

About a mile further on there is an exit for the A6 to Matlock. Come off here, and take the **second** exit from the roundabout signposted A6 to Matlock.

In a couple of miles you come to Duffield, and half a mile after the Duffield sign there is a set of traffic lights with a left turn, the B5023, signposted to Wirksworth, which you should take.

This takes you out of Duffield into the country, and just over a mile after you leave Duffield, you come to the Puss in Boots (set back from the road on your left), with a right turn opposite it signposted to Hazelwood.

Take the right turn.

You go immediately over a small bridge, and then a larger one. On the left are three or four houses together, which you ignore. We are about 100 yards further on.



As you come round a gentle right hand bend, there on the left are the "Knowle Farm" and "Duck Pond View" signs in green, and the entrance to the CL is past the house on the left. Call at the house, but if we are not in, go through the double gates and find a pitch.
